## GUIDELINES FOR STRANDED MEMBERS OF MALAYSIA MY SECOND HOME (MM2H) TO REENTER MALAYSIA DURING MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO)

These guidelines are intended to provide guidance for all members of the MM2H who are stranded abroad during the Movement Control Order to re-enter Malaysia.

These guidelines have taken into account all standard operating procedures and protocols observed from Department of Immigration Malaysia and National Security Council meeting the requirements to reenter Malaysia against the backdrop of COVID-19 pandemic.

## The steps are as follows:

- a. Kindly provide your particulars namely name/nationality, passport number, country stranded at, and contact number as well as email address at the following link <a href="https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAlpQLSdGmqlolPh06TQP-sMy3zMOr7lj0hhPmyxfiNsB8WomB8Fsg/viewform">https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAlpQLSdGmqlolPh06TQP-sMy3zMOr7lj0hhPmyxfiNsB8WomB8Fsg/viewform</a>. Upon doing so your names will be registered under Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture, Malaysia and will be shared with the Department of Immigration Malaysia.
- b. You will have to undergo the medical screening swab test at the country you are stranded at, of maximum 14 days before your arrival at Malaysia International Airport. Please provide the result of the test to the authority at the entry point. Positive COVID-19 result will be deny entry and subject to other immigration procedures.
- c. Members of MM2H must agree to be quarantine for 14 days at assigned quarantine station and must prepare an undertaking letter stating your readiness to bear the cost of the 14 days accommodation. Non-negotiable.

- d. All the terms will be subject to latest Immigration procedures imposed at entry point which will be updated as see fit.
- e. This guidelines is effective as of 18 May 2020.
