



# INFORMATION / CHECKLIST FOR TRAVELLERS TO MALAYSIA

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

### Malaysians:

There are no restrictions for Malaysian citizens to travel back to Malaysia

### Non-Malaysians:

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Undergo quarantine for a 14-day period, either at government-designated quarantine hotels upon arrival in Malaysia or be considered for home quarantine through application that will be reviewed by Ministry of Health (MOH), Malaysia
- Present a negative RT-PCR Covid-19 test result (nasal/deep throat swab test) upon arrival in Malaysia.
- Subject to RT-PCR Covid-19 test upon arrival at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) or other relevant international entry points into Malaysia. Another RT-PCR Covid-19 test will be conducted on the 10th day of quarantine.

## HOME QUARANTINE (HSO)

- Home quarantine applications are to be submitted to the MOH, Malaysia via email at [hso@moh.gov.my](mailto:hso@moh.gov.my) for approval with relevant supporting documents, **TWO (2) WEEKS** before departure to Malaysia
- Home quarantine for travellers who have completed their vaccinations is NOT automatic.
- Applications are subject to approval following risk assessment by MOH.

Applications will be reviewed based on the following conditions:

- Home/Residence address, suitability of home condition and type/number of occupant/s at home during quarantine (senior citizens, children below 12, those with underlying medical condition, pregnant mothers, etc)
- Final dose administered at least 14 days/28 days (depending on the type of vaccine) prior to arrival in Malaysia

## BEFORE DEPARTURE

- Submit an application to be home-quarantined via email to [hso@moh.gov.my](mailto:hso@moh.gov.my), **TWO (2) WEEKS** before departure to Malaysia and bring along the approval email (hardcopy), if applicable.
- Undergo RT-PCR COVID-19 test within 3 days before departure and bring along the negative result certificate (hardcopy).
- Pay the relevant charges to the Malaysian Government (COVID-19 test & quarantine, if relevant).
- Download and activate the *MySejahtera* application before departure to Malaysia. ([https://mysejahtera.malaysia.gov.my/intro\\_en/](https://mysejahtera.malaysia.gov.my/intro_en/))

## OTHER INFORMATION

- Besides HSO, travellers can choose either basic or premium accommodation type. The basic package will be under the arrangement of NADMA and based on their current list of quarantine hotels.

## LOU & TRAVEL NOTICE

- Effective 1st May 2021, travellers headed to Malaysia are no longer required to present a Letter of Undertaking and Indemnity (LOU) and Travel Notice to the relevant authorities upon arrival.
