FAQs

- How do you know my child's level of English to teach him/her?

We will send an online English test so we can place your child in the appropriate group during English lessons

- Where are your teachers from?

The teachers teaching the lessons and supervising are qualified and experienced teachers from our schools. At the same time, we have camp leaders who are seniors in the school to supervise and lead the students while in a small group.

- Can my child enrol in your school after the camp?

Yes! Your child has an advantage as he/she has gone through the English test in the camp.

- There are no direct flights to Penang from my country. What can I do?

You may enquire from Malaysian Airlines (MAS) or Singapore Airlines (SQ) as they provide unaccompanied minor services (under 15 years old)

- What should my child bring for the camp?

We will provide a packing list after your register for the camp.

FAQs

- What if my child is homesick?

We will have close communication and assure your child during the camp. He/she can contact you through his/her mobile if necessary. Along the way, we hope your child will make new friends and feel better after the first day.

- How much money should my child bring?

We will include that in the packing list and also indicate in the programme which activity they can do some shopping.

- Are the activities supervised?

Yes, there will always be an adult(s) with the camp groups all the time.

- Will they receive anything during the camp?

Yes, they will all graduate with certificates, including the English programme.

- How much does it cost?

RM8,500 per child (excluding air flights, insurance & personal shopping)
